Why Conyers?

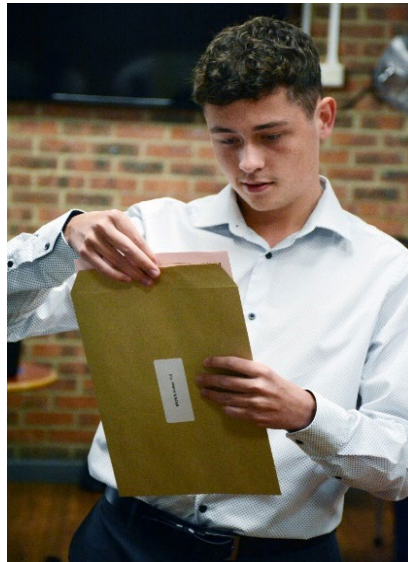

- More than 95% leavers sustained their destination in Education or Employment

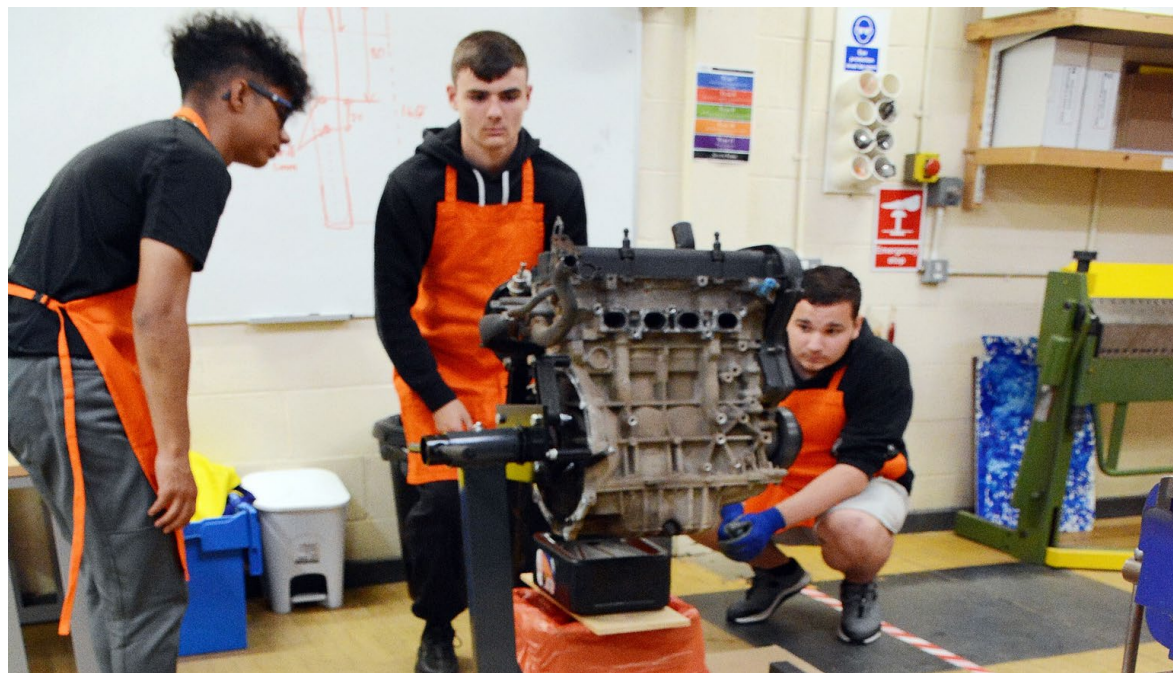

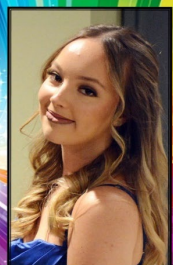

Core Maths

Extended Project Qualification (EPQ)



Minimum Entry Requirements

- Students who achieve **five** standard passes or above including Maths and English at GCSE will be considered for **A-Level** courses
- Students who achieve **four** standard passes or above at GCSE will be considered for a **BTEC** Extended Diploma course

What if you only pass Maths or English?

Additional Subject Specific entry requirements

Maths	Grade 6 in Maths
Further Maths	Grade 7 in Maths
Physics	Grade 6 in Physics or 66 in Double Award Science or Grade 6 in Maths or studying Core Maths
Chemistry	Grade 6 in Chemistry or 66 in Double Award Science
Biology	Grade 6 in Biology or 66 in Double Award Science

Additional Subject Specific entry requirements

PE	Playing, coaching or officiating competitively in at least one regular sport
Music	Working towards Grade 5 in Music Theory and working at grade 4 in chosen instrument
Computing	Grade 5 in Maths
Economics	Grade 5 in Maths or studying Core Maths
Modern Languages	Grade 6 in the language to be studied

A Levels / BTECs

- 'A' Levels and BTECs are hard!
- Progression into Year 13 requires a pass at the end of Year 12 exams
- Transition to Sixth Form starts now!
